

Hoke County Health Department Family Planning Services



The Hoke County Health Department provides Family Planning services to female and male clients of reproductive age. Services are provided without regard to religion, race, color, national origin, handicapping condition, age, sex, number of pregnancies or marital status. Charges for services are based on a sliding scale fee using the number of family members living at home and income at that time. No client is denied services for inability to pay.

Contraceptive Methods Available Include:

- Natural Family Planning
- Oral Contraceptives
- Depo-Provera Injection
- Condoms
- Intrauterine devices (IUDs)
- Nexplanon birth control implant
- Plan B emergency contraceptive
- Prescriptions may be provided for methods such as birth control patch and vaginal ring
- Referrals are made for clients desiring Bilateral Tubal Ligation and Vasectomy

Hoke County Health Department provides youth-friendly services called Teen-Time for teens between 11-19 years of age. Teen Time is held every first and third Monday of each month.

Interpreters are on-site for non-English speaking patients at no cost to the patient.

Family planning appointments are made Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 10:30 am and 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm.
