



## Hoke County Medication Assistance Program

The purpose of the program is to help anyone 18 and older without prescription drug coverage to receive medication at no cost or low cost out of pocket.

Our licensed pharmacist will educate/counsel on proper medication management and check for possible drug interactions.

### Eligibility Requirements

- No prescription coverage
- You must have a current physician
- Medicare Part D recipients are eligible when in coverage gap
- Resident of Hoke and surrounding counties
- Meet Income Requirements
- **18 years old and up**

### Simple and Easy Process

- Call for an appointment
- Picture ID
- Bring a current medication list from your physician with you to your appointment
- Bring Proof of Income for ALL household members:
  - Social Security Award benefit letter
  - Alimony/Child support statement
  - unemployment benefit statement
  - Pay stubs
  - If **NO** income you will be provided with a letter of support form for person providing support and a no income/prescription insurance letter for the physician to sign
- If you file taxes bring the most recent tax return
