

# HOKE COUNTY PUBLIC NOTICE

## Penny Rounding for Cash Transactions

### ONLY!! Effective April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026

Due to the U.S. Mint discontinuing penny production, our office will begin rounding totals on cash transactions only starting April 1<sup>st</sup>.

When penny inventory is insufficient to make exact change, transaction totals will be rounded to the nearest \$0.05 using the following guidelines:

- Amounts ending in \$0.01 or \$0.02 will be rounded **down** to \$0.00
- Amounts ending in \$0.03 or \$0.04 will be rounded **up** to \$0.05
- Amounts ending in \$0.06 or \$0.07 will be rounded **down** to \$0.05
- Amounts ending in \$0.08 or \$0.09 will be rounded **up** to \$0.10

#### Important Notes:

- Debit, credit, and electronic payments will NOT be rounded and will be charged the exact amount plus any applicable fees
- The rounding adjustment will result in a small increase or decrease in the final cash total due

*We highly encourage you to use other forms of payment such as checks, money order, and/or debit/credit card (with applicable fee) to reduce the impact of coin shortages!*
